Dear Student:

In order to receive federal financial aid a student must demonstrate satisfactory academic progress toward the completion of a degree program. A review of your academic record indicates that you are not in compliance with Kent State University's Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (see enclosed brochure) for the reason(s) indicated below.


- \_\_\_ 1. **GPA:** Your cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) is below 2.0.
  
- \_\_\_ 2. **Percentage Complete:** You did not complete 67% (60% if you have earned 0-29 hours) of the hours attempted during the last award year (i.e., summer 2008, fall 2008, spring 2009 semesters).
  
- \_\_\_ 3. **Maximum Time Frame:** The number of hours you attempted exceeds the limitations (outlined below) for receiving federal financial aid. NOTE: Attempted hours include transfer hours, forgiveness hours, and all grades including IN, IP, NA, NF, NR, S, SA, SF, U, W, Y, and Z.
  - a. \_\_\_\_\_ 175 hours for a bachelor's degree (4 year degree)
  - b. \_\_\_\_\_ 80 hours for an associate degree (2 year degree)

Your federal financial aid has been put on hold for the 2009 – 2010 award year. This applies even if you already received a financial aid award letter.

Although standards have not been maintained, we would like to encourage students with extenuating circumstances to submit an appeal to the Student Financial Aid Office. Some examples of extenuating circumstances include but are not limited to: (1) illness or injury of the student, (2) death of a relative of the student or (3) other crisis situations. Please complete the Appeal Form located on the reverse side of this letter; attach a personal statement and documentation and return the form to the Student Financial Aid Office at the address below. Regional campus students should submit appeal letters to their respective campus Student Services Office.

It is important to submit the appeal as soon as possible. The Academic Progress Appeals Committee will review your appeal. **You will not receive a paper letter to inform you of the Committee's decision.** To view the decision you must: (1) Access Flash Line (2) click on Student Tools (3) click on Financial Aid and (4) click on Financial Aid Status. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact your personal financial aid representative. Please disregard this letter if you do not wish to be considered for federal financial aid.
