- A minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA.
Some programs have specific GPA requirements for content (e.g. 2.6 GPA in all mathematics courses for Integrated Mathematics Majors) or professional coursework (e.g. 3.0 GPA in professional coursework for all Intervention Specialist majors). See requirement sheets for specifics.
Rating of "Acceptable" on professional dispositions.

Additional specific requirements for admission to advanced study:

- C or better in Education in a Democratic Society and a C or better in one of the following: Educational Psychology, Educational Technology, Introduction to Exceptionalities.
C or better in each freshman writing course.
Electronic signature for Professional Education Agreements (e.g. Verification of Moral Character)

- Student must maintain a 3.0 average in all work. A student who fails to maintain a 3.0 average is subject to dismissal. In addition, in order to qualify for graduation, a 3.0 average must be maintained for all graduate coursework.
- Grades below "C (2.0)" are not counted toward completion of requirements for any advanced degree, but are counted in evaluating a student's grade point average. Only graduate course credits count toward a graduate degree. A graduate student who receives a combination of more than 7 hours of "C (2.0)" or lower grades or more than 4 hours of grades lower than "C (2.0)" is subject to dismissal.
